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COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

1. Landfill Site reported with 47 years of life left

The Township recently worked with Pinchin, our regular Landfill Site Monitoring team, to review how many years are left before the landfill reaches capacity. A 2023 survey and 2024 volume reports estimated 47 years of remaining life.

Since then, two big changes have made a difference: the purchase of a landfill compactor and strong community participation in the clear bag program. To see how these improvements, along with the new provincial recycling program, affect landfill use, the Township will now complete a volume survey every year for the next five years. This will help create a benchmark and track trends, after which surveys will be done every five years.

With these efforts, we expect the landfill's life to extend well beyond the original estimate. Thank you to all residents for supporting these changes and helping protect this important community resource.

2. Road work tenders accepted

Council received the tender submissions and reports to summer/fall road work at the meeting. Planned work to be completed this year includes:

1. Winter Sand stockpile and pickling, (when we add the salt to the sand) \$50,000 plus salt (approx. \$23,000) and taxes
2. The Granular A Stockpile replenished, \$97,092 plus tax
3. Double Surface treatment on two partial roads, \$184,690 plus tax
 - a) Development Road from Rutherglen Line to Mount Pleasant Road
 - b) Pine Lake Road end of current treated surface to Shields Point intersection
4. Gravel application on the municipal portion of Shields Point Road, \$53,462.50 plus tax

Some of these projects will cause traffic disruptions and as we plan the details we will keep you informed

3. Improvements to Medical Center for increased privacy

Council has approved a soundproofing project at the Medical Centre to reduce noise between rooms. This upgrade will give patients more privacy when discussing their health.

It's a great improvement for our growing healthcare team – we're fortunate to now have two doctors at the Medical Centre.
